

The Gadabout Gaddis Cup Award 2021-Nomination Form

The award is presented by the Maine Aeronautics Association every other year on the last Sunday of September (subject to change) at the Gadabout Gaddis Airport in Bingham in recognition of those who keep aviation strong and viable in Maine.

The annual Gadabout Gaddis Award is presented by the MAA to an individual or organization who has fostered and supported aviation in Maine and made significant contributions to the flying community. A number of factors are important to consider in the nomination process. The nominee does not need to be a pilot, but must have made (past or present) undeniable contributions to the advancement of aviation in Maine. All nominations will be considered by the MAA board of directors.

This award recognizes the accomplishments and significance of an individual or group that best exemplifies the spirit of Gadabout "Roscoe Vernon' Gaddis" the flying fisherman from Maine. He brought the magic of fishing to the masses during the pioneering days of radio and then television with his weekly TV series "The Flying Fisherman". He built the airstrip in Bingham from where the series was based.

This award has been presented for over 30 years to those who have supported and shaped aviation in Maine and whose passions have championed general aviation throughout Maine and New England. Past winners include: Duke Tomlin, Grady Sharpe, Telford Allen, Max Folsom, Keith Strange, Steve Welch, Mike Muchmore, and "Ma" Twitchell.
